Dear Senator,

The National Committee for the Recording Arts is fighting for its rights to get royalties from the broadcasters for the recording artists, the same as the organizations of composers and publishers are receiving.

I protest strongly, with my colleagues, against the abuse made by the broadcasters of our recordings, without any compensation for our work.

There is no reason why such a discrimination should exist and I hope you will support the amendment offered by Senator Harrison Williams Jr. (D.N.J.)
