#### 7. ENROLMENT FEES

As soon as the selections have been completed, participants must pay the following enrolment fees at the Student Secretariat of the Fundación Isaac Albéniz in Santander (Palacio de Festivales):

Auditors:	25,000 pesetas
Direct Students:	50,000 pesetas
Duos:	75,000 pesetas
Trios:	100,000 pesetas
Quartets:	125,000 pesetas
Quintets:	150,000 pesetas

Students resident in the Community of Cantabria will be given a 50% reduction in their enrolment fees.

#### 8. ACCOMMODATION

Information regarding accommodations in Santander will be provided to students by the Summer Course organisation.

#### 9. SCHOLARSHIPS

The *Fundación Isaac Albéniz*, in collaboration with the Cantabrian Regional Council, the Santander City Hall, Caja Cantabria, the Marcelino Botín Foundation, "Juventudes Musicales" of Madrid, and the Ministry of Culture, will award a limited number of scholarships, for which all participants may apply.

There are two kinds of scholarship grants:

- a) Full: These cover enrolment fees, lodging as arranged by the organisation, and per diem for board.

- b) Tuition only: These cover only the enrolment fees.

Those who wish to apply for either type of the above grants must fill in the application, accompanied with the following documentation:

- a) a statement of his or her personal or family financial situation;
- b) an attested copy of the applicant's income tax return from the immediately preceding fiscal year, as well as that of the family unit to which he or she belongs (even if he or she is no longer a dependent).

Those to whom scholarships are awarded, whether direct students or auditors, are obliged to attend the classes and lectures.

Discovery of any falsified facts in the required documentation will result in the automatic expulsion of the applicant or student.
