

CONCERTS ORGANISED FOR THE WINNERS  
OF THE NINTH EDITION

- **The First prizewinner** will make a tour of Europe, the U.S.A., Central and South America, consisting of more than 100 concerts and recitals, at famous concert halls and festivals. This tour will include presentation performances in Madrid with the National Symphony and the Spanish Radio and Television Orchestras (in the Teatro Real), in Barcelona with the Barcelona City Orchestra (in the Palau de la Música); recitals in New York (92<sup>nd</sup> Street Concert Series); Washington (the Kennedy Centre); London (the Queen Elizabeth Hall); Vienna (the Musikverein), as well as a presentation in Paris and a recording that will be published under the 'DECCA' label.
- **The Second Prizewinner** will make a tour of Spain as well as receive possible invitations from abroad.
- **The Third Prizewinner** will have a tour of recitals in Spain organised.
- **The best qualified competitor of Spanish nationality** in this edition will be awarded a scholarship to study abroad, sponsored by the Ministry of Culture, and will have a recital tour of Spain organised as well as a recording sponsored by the firm of ETNOS.
