

- Three opera arias of their own choice. All arias preceded by a recitative, this will also be required in the audition.
- Three *Lieder*. The first *Lied* to be chosen from the German repertoire. The second and third to be freely chosen from the Italian, French and Spanish repertoires.

For **Oboe** auditions the repertoire will consist of two solo pieces chosen from:

- Telemann: Fantasia for solo recorder No. 6 in D minor.
- A Schumann Romance from the Three Romances, opus 94.
- Antal Dorati: Five Pieces for Oboe.  
1st: "La formica e la cicala".  
5th: "Légère de main".

For **Horn** auditions the repertoire will consist of:

- A Mozart horn concerto chosen from KV 417, 474, 495.
- A Strauss horn concerto: either No. 1 in E flat major opus 11 or No. 2 in E flat major.
- One work freely chosen from the 20th century repertoire.

## 7. ENROLLMENT FEES. SCHOLARSHIPS

To reserve their place, accepted candidates must pay the sum of 50,000 pesetas to the *Reina Sofia School of Music* prior to June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2000.

*Tuition fees* for the 2000-2001 academic year are 2,400,000 pesetas which must be paid prior to September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2000.

The Isaac Albéniz Foundation offers three types of scholarships:

- Tuition Fees Scholarship. Covers the total or partial amount of the tuition fees.
- Living Expenses Scholarship. Covers the costs of room and board at the *Reina Sofia School of Music* Residence during the academic year.

- Instrument Scholarship. Allows the enrolled student to use quality musical instruments during the academic year.

These scholarships are funded by the Isaac Albéniz Foundation and by various public and private institutions dedicated to aiding training and artistic development. The scholarships are awarded by the Scholarships' Commission of the Isaac Albéniz Foundation which is composed of representatives of the Fundación, of the *Reina Sofia School of Music* and of the sponsors. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the audition results and the applicant's financial circumstances as reflected in the documents submitted for that purpose.

Those wishing to apply for any of the above scholarships must, together with the general documentation required for the application, also submit the following:

- a) Attested photocopies of the applicant's own Income Tax Return for the immediately preceding fiscal year, and that of the family unit to which she or he belongs (even if no longer under its guardianship).
- b) An attested photocopy of the Property Tax Return for the immediately preceding fiscal year or a sworn statement of exemption from such Tax.
